Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District (the "Board") will hold a regular public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas, said address being a meeting place of the District.

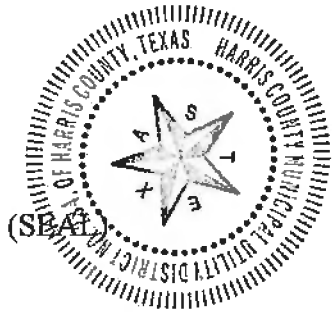
The meeting will be held *Tuesday, January 7, 2025, at 12:00 Noon.*

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action necessary or appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public Comments;
2. Review and approval of the minutes of the Board of Directors meeting of December 3, 2024;
3. Security Report;
4. Presentation by Harris County Public Health relative to the Wastewater-Based Epidemiology Program;
5. Authorize preparation and submission of District information to Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts as required by Section 403.0241, Texas Government Code, and Chapter 203, Texas Local Government Code, for inclusion in the Special Purpose District Public Information Database;
6. Approve Continuing Disclosure Report; and authorize Continuing Disclosure Counsel to file Report with appropriate repositories (due February 28, 2025);
7. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports; authorize the payment of invoices presented;
8. Tax Assessor-Collector's Report, including status of delinquent taxes; authorize the payment of invoices presented, approval of tax refunds, and transfer of accounts to the uncollectible roll;
9. Review of Delinquent Tax Collection Attorneys' Report from Perdue, Brandon, Fielder, Collins & Mott, L.L.P.; authorize any action necessary and appropriate in connection therewith, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
10. Adoption of Resolution Authorizing an Additional Penalty on Delinquent Personal Property Taxes and authorize delinquent tax attorney to collect delinquent personal property taxes beginning April 1, 2025, including the filing of lawsuits, as necessary;
11. Discussion of exemptions from taxation for 2025, and adoption of a Resolution in connection therewith;
12. Discussion regarding tax-exempt multi-family development within the District and authorize any actions necessary in connection therewith;

13. Operation and Maintenance Report, including:
  - A. Monthly report;
  - B. Authorizing the repair and maintenance of District facilities, and the taking of any action in connection therewith and authorize acceptance of Texas Ethics Commission ("TEC") Form 1295, including:
    - i. Authorize the repair or replacement of headworks screen at Wastewater Treatment Plant; and
    - ii. Authorize repair or replacement of Drum Screen at Wastewater Treatment Plant ("WWTP");
  - C. Appeals of District charges;
  - D. Refer accounts for collection;
  - E. Approve write-offs of uncollectible accounts;
  - F. Discussion regarding status of manhole repairs; and
  - G. Compliance with permits and regulatory requirements, including review of any notices of violations, responses to notices and remedial action taken, self-reporting forms as and if required, and correspondence to and from regulatory agencies regarding same;
  
14. Engineer's Report, including:
  - A. Authorizing the design and/or advertisement for bids for construction of facilities within the District, approving of related storm water plans, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295;
    - i. Review and approval of any Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans or Storm Water Quality Management Plans related to construction within or on behalf of the District, and the execution of any documentation in connection therewith, including WWTP site permit;
  - B. Authorizing the award of construction contracts or concurrence of award of contracts for the construction of facilities within the District, and approval of any related storm water permits and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295;
  - C. Status of construction of facilities to serve land within the District, including the approval of any pay estimates and/or change orders and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295;
  - D. Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and the acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes, including:
    - i. Easements to be dedicated from Fidelis to the District relative to the multifamily project;
  - E. West Harris County Regional Water Authority surface water conversion matters;
  - F. Status of Advanced Groundwater Solutions, LLC's Water Optimization Report; and
  - G. Status of acceptance by Harris County of streets and storm sewers for maintenance;

  - A. Review Weingarten Bear Creek's ("WBC") feasibility study on the downstream elements affected by increasing the lift station capacity in connection with WBC's request to increase its capacity from 481 ESFCs to 525 ESFCs; and

*Pursuant to Sections 49.062(c) and (c-1) of the Texas Water Code, if fifty or more qualified electors reside in the District, five or more of said electors may make a written request to the Board to designate a meeting place and hold meetings within the District. The Board must grant such request unless no suitable meeting place exists inside the District, in which case a meeting place within ten miles of the boundary of the District may be designated. On the failure to designate a qualifying meeting place, five electors may petition the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to designate a qualifying meeting place.*
